2021-2022 ADVISER Status

- Certification Status and details are available at <https://www.education.ne.gov/dataservices/2021-2022-adviser-vendor-certification/>
- Fall Collection was finished on 10/31
 - NDE currently working through the last of the late tickets/data change requests and then this will be finalized
- New language code suggested – Dari
 - Dialect of Farsi spoken in Afghanistan
 - Once NDE makes the code available this week, please contact your SIS vendor if you would like to use it
 - Some SIS may need software updates to support this, others may just need to call an update of the language codes



2021-2022 ADVISER Status

- NDE is still working out some of details with reporting the new transfer out exit codes, especially with optioning
 - Will release a tweaked version of the *Systems Involved Student Reporting* document when ready
 - Any new validation errors related to exit codes will not be turned on until after this is studied
- Some course-based reports still pending: Programs of Study, Instructional Units (new)

2020-2021 Follow Up Collection

- NDE is immediately working through any graduation cohort change requests that come in so that they can be reflected in the 2020-2021 NEP
 - Once the NEP is opened to the public next week (11/17) any further cohort changes won't be reflected on the NEP until next year
 - Districts may review their data in the NEP Secure app on the NDE Portal now
 - Some of these are unavoidable due to the new Follow Up due date
- Changes to the new Follow Up process next year:
 - NDE will roll over the follow up reports and current year errors that look back at the prior year (439, 523, etc.) to point to the newly locked data right after 10/2 (and then make late changes from there)
 - Place all of these cross-year errors into their own category, so districts know exactly which ones to look at before 10/2



2020-2021 CRDC Collection

- The CRDC collection website opens to districts and NDE on 12/13
 - Resources for districts available from the USDOE at <https://crdc.grads360.org/>
- CRDC says they will import and/or verify some data from EDFacts automatically, refer to this document for more info:

 - FYI EDFacts is the system where all district data required to be reported by NDE is sent to the USDOE each year, regardless of CRDC
- NDE will verify what other data can be submitted after the 12/13 opening date on districts' behalf, more updates about submission process to come in NDE's bulletin
- If a district wishes to opt out of NDE submitting data on their behalf where possible, please email ADVISERHelp@nebraskacloud.org to ask for a "CRDC opt out"
