

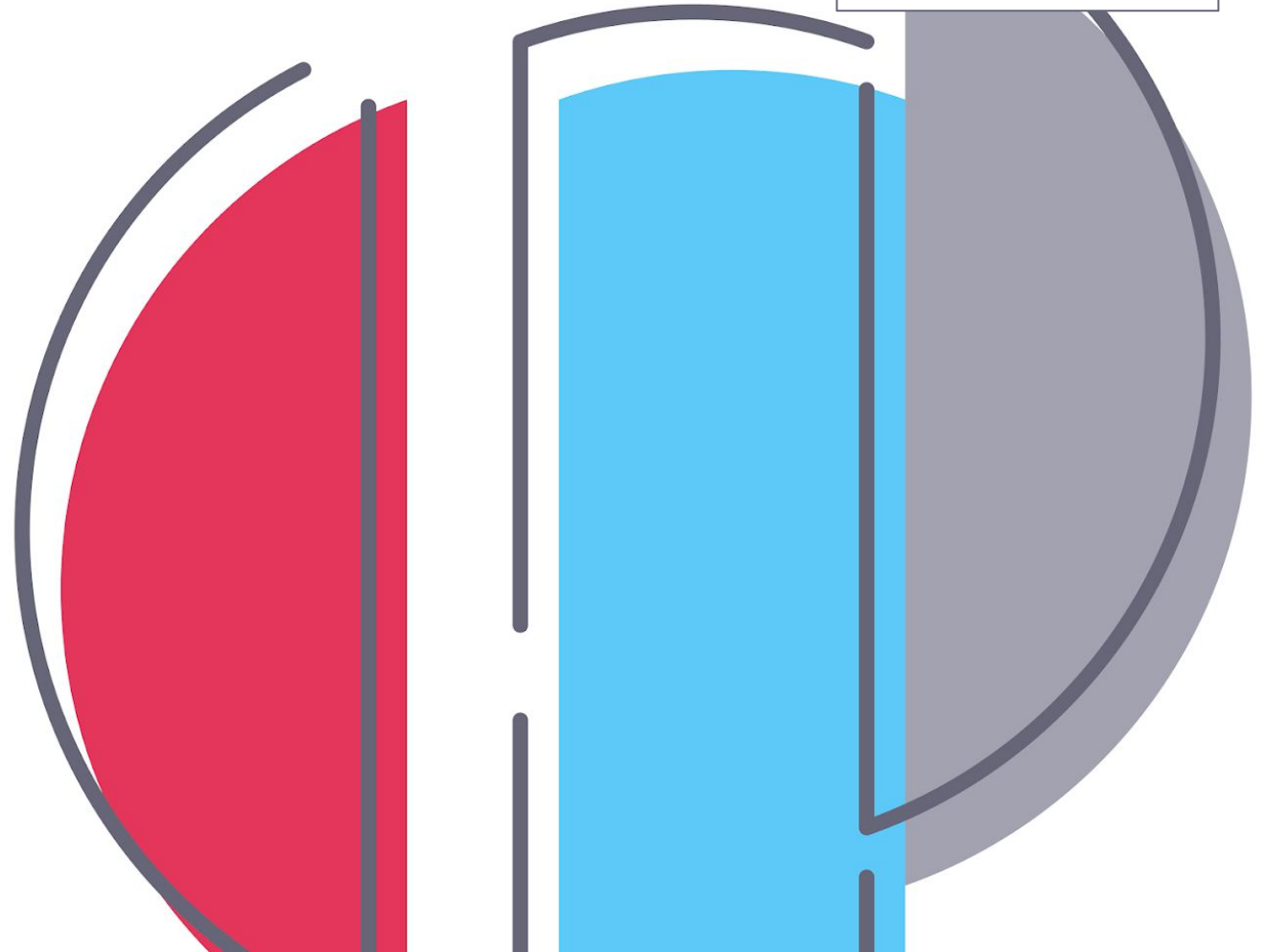

# Providing Context - Library / Media Staffing

## **RULE 10: Accredited Public and Nonpublic Schools**

### **007.04A**

Each K-12 school system and each secondary school system has a person holding a Nebraska Teaching Certificate with an endorsement appropriate for library science or educational media specialist, or meeting Section 007.04B (next slide), assigned on at least a one-half time basis to provide library media services to the school system.



# Providing Context - Library / Media Staffing

## RULE 10: Accredited Public and Nonpublic Schools

**007.04B** A school system may assign a person holding a Nebraska Teaching Certificate with no endorsement appropriate for library science or educational media specialist to fulfill the requirements for Sections 007.04A, 007.04A1, and 007.04A2 **if such person acquires at least six credit hours each year toward an appropriate endorsement** pursuant to 92 NAC 24.



# Providing Context – Counselor Staffing

## **RULE 10: Accredited Public and Nonpublic Schools**

### **007.05A**

Each K-12 and each secondary school system assigns at least a one-half time equivalency person to conduct a guidance and counseling program. The level of assignment is determined by the local school system and the person assigned holds a guidance and counseling endorsement appropriate for the level(s) assigned. When enrollment in a school system exceeds 400, the system assigns at least one full-time equivalency appropriately endorsed person.



# Providing Context – Counselor Staffing

## **RULE 10: Accredited Public and Nonpublic Schools**

**007.05D** A person holding a Nebraska Teaching Certificate with no endorsement appropriate for guidance and counseling may be assigned to fulfill the requirements of Sections 007.05A and 007.05B if such person has two years of teaching experience and acquires at least six credit hours each year toward an endorsement appropriate for guidance and counseling pursuant to 92 NAC 24.

**007.05E** In nonpublic schools, clergy holding a Nebraska teaching or administrative certificate may be assigned to fulfill the requirement of Sections 007.05A and 007.05B.



# 6 Credit Hours Per Year Rationale

**School Counselor Endorsement is a Graduate Level program that requires 36\* credit hours.** (M.A. in Counseling)

- **Currently in NE:** Chadron State, Concordia University, Creighton University, Doane University, UNK, UNL, UNO, and Wayne State.
- **Position Codes** for Staff Reporting:
  - **2120 / 2121** (Counselor)
  - **2222** (Librarian) / **2223** (Media Specialist)
- **“Data Pull”** occurs after staff reporting is finalized in October.
  - If a person is added after Nov. 1st please notify the Service Desk.
- 50% of program completed, secure a Provisional Endorsement.

**November 30th, 2021** - Collection is launched.

**DUE DATE Extended** - March 31, 2022

**Reminder Email** - March 18th for schools with no data entered.

# Addressing Unmet Progress

- 1) During the **audit window** NDE staff will be in communication about collection errors, missing data and initial deficiencies.
- 2) After the audit window NDE staff will **confirm deficiencies** with individual school administrators.
- 3) For unmet progress on **007.04B and 007.05D**, Accreditation will request a response from the school.
- 4) Within 30 days the school replies with a **corrective measures** that involves steps to meet compliance for the 2022-23 school year.
- 5) By November 1st 2022, schools report their compliance on Instructional Units per the **Assurance Statement**.
