

CRDC Updates

- The OCR will be sending out 20-21 CRDC data quality checks to some district administrators soon (details not known currently)
 - If a district gets one of these checks, they must respond/make corrections in the CRDC by a date in June
- NDE working on posting 21-22 CRDC validation reports before June
 - 21-22 CRDC collection will occur in Feb. 2023
 - Will look to add feature for districts to generate their own CRDC upload files from ADVISER

m Pandemic-EBT File Uploads

- The P-EBT File Upload app in the NDE Portal is open for 2021-2022 files
- The due date for the third round of benefits is Monday
 5/16 for August March data
 - Districts may catch up and submit this data before the last due date as well
- The <u>NDE Nutrition Services</u> website has updated PEBT guidance and resources for the 2021-2022 rules
 - Includes upload Instructions, submission calendar, webinar recording/slides, and FAQ

表 2022-2023 ADVISER Changes

- New collection <u>calendar</u> and new <u>course code catalog</u> available now
- Documentation for <u>SIS Vendors</u> available now (updated 5/10), sandboxes within 2 weeks
- 22-23 Data Elements guide before end of May
- Student Section Association Attempt Status
- Course Offering Instructional Time Planned
 - If a district has multiple values for this for a single course offering, NDE is requiring that the average amount be reported
- Disability code 03 "Hearing Impaired" will be relabeled as 03 "Deaf or Hard of Hearing" to match state special education rules

表 2022-2023 ADVISER Changes

- After further review, some of the discipline changes mentioned last month for LB154 are not needed
 - The language referring to alternative schools is referring to Rule 17, which is covered by expulsion with services
 - The language referring to physical interventions is referring to physical restraint events
- There are only two discipline changes planned for 22-23 related to LB154
 - Restraint Event is now a state accountability element, not just for CRDC
 - New Behavior codes to cover statute 79-267:
- (ii) Offense constituting grounds for a long-term suspension, an expulsion, or a mandatory reassignment pursuant to section 79-267, regardless of consequences assigned; and

The conduct can be carried out by school employees, other students, and non-employee third parties.
