2021-2022 ADVISER Status

- SIS vendors are all certified or conditionally certified
- Certification Status and details are available at <https://www.education.ne.gov/dataservices/2021-2022-adviser-vendor-certification/>
- Fall Collection (membership, etc.) is due 10/15 and will be locked 10/31
 - Fall District Administrator sign off will be available around 10/28
- New Calendar Event code – ~~Closed for Health Emergency/COVID-19~~
 - NDE will **not** be implementing this code, the field would not be specific enough to be useful



2021-2022 ADVISER Status

- NDE is still working out some of details with reporting the new transfer out exit codes, especially with optioning
 - Will release a tweaked version of the *Systems Involved Student Reporting* document
 - Any new validation errors related to exit codes will not be turned on until after the Fall collection window
- New report still pending for calculating Instructional Units from courses (after Fall)

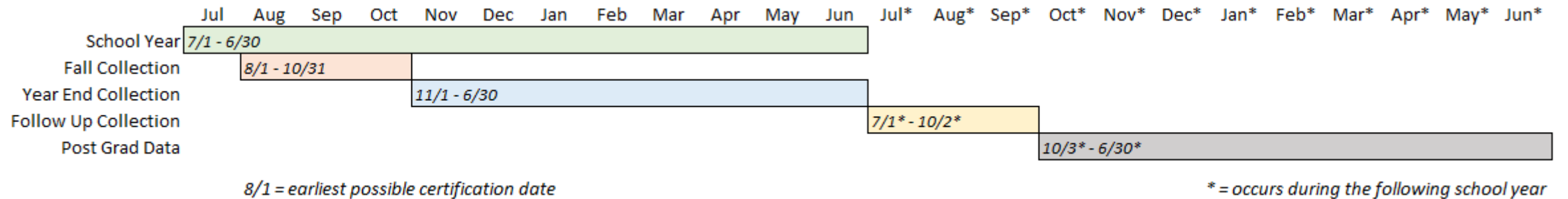
2020-2021 Follow Up Collection

- 2020-2021 Follow Up collection data locked 10/2 (SPED, graduates, dropouts, courses)
 - Follow Up collection District Administrator sign off still open
 - NDE is working through late requests, getting corrected data put into our temporary Follow Up locked database
 - Once late requests are finished, NDE will move the locked follow up data into the 2020-2021 Year End Snapshot reports (only the areas that are part of the follow up)
 - This will be the final 2020-2021 data that will be used for federal SPED reporting and graduates/dropouts on the NEP
 - NDE working to finish up the Follow Up late requests by 10/15
 - Lookups in ADVISER Validation will be changed to show this finalized 2020-2021 data in November



Follow Up Collection Timing

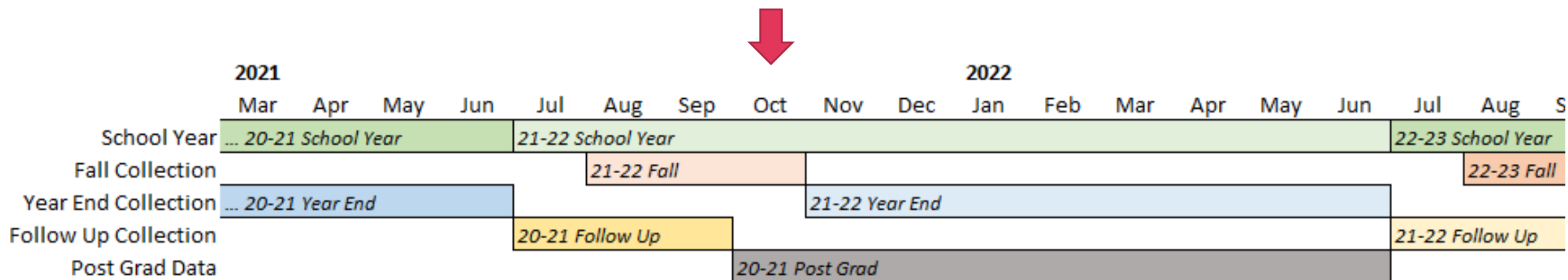
- These are the collection windows for a typical school year:

Follow Up Collection Timing

- There are **always two school years available** in ADVISER for receiving data at any time, for a full 12 months after the end of the school year
 - Each school year's data is collected using its own self-contained Ed-Fi database which has its own set of codes & rules that does not change when the following school year begins
 - E.g. sending up 2020-2021 enrollments still uses the 201 exit code
- Any data that gets deleted from your live ODS (enrollment changes, programs, courses, etc.) has the potential to cause issues with these later collections
- NDE will work with SIS vendors to focus on avoiding issues with prior year data
 - Note: some SIS handle the prior year data syncing without the district having a user interface for it
