 - Lookups

21-22 CDC



Substitute Teachers - 2nd collection window open now through June 15 (Audit Close: June 30)

- Ensures all Substitutes have valid certificates
- Report total Days Worked for entire 21-22 school year
 - This is associated within their certification record as Experience
 - Assists with their future renewals and connects Subs to Districts
- If districts approve the collection and need to make updates after, contact the Service Desk to have it re-opened

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20-21 Perkins V Post School Survey continued ...

- Post Graduate activity data reported in 20-21 ADVISER
- To view Verification Reports change School Year to 20-21
 - **Perkins V Post School Survey List** - lists the 2021 concentrators who graduated and need to be surveyed
 - **Post Graduate Activity** - list of 2021 graduates surveyed and reported
 - **Students Missing Post Graduate Activity** - a list of 2021 graduates who are not reported
 - **Download NSC Data** - will display National Student Clearinghouse data



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SPED Post School Outcomes

- 20-21 SPED Exiters: Survey sent end of May 2022 to 20-21 SPED exiters
 - Too late to make changes to this data
- 21-22: Now, view 21-22 data to know who will be surveyed in May 2023
 - SPED exiters from 21-22 school year



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ADVISER Validation Verification Reports – to review by June 15

- **Full Year** - any students enrolled in your district at any time during the school year, even if already exited
- **As of Today** - students who are enrolled in your district today, can be used for comparing against reports in your SIS
- **As of October 1st** - students enrolled in membership or SPED programs on 10/1, according to what is currently in ADVISER

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ADVISER Validation Verification Reports continued ...

- **As of October 1st (Locked)** - students enrolled in membership or SPED programs on 10/1, according to the state accountability data that was locked on 11/1
- **End of Year** - Available May 1st - students enrolled at the end of the school year, according to the state accountability data that will be locked on 7/1
- **End of Year (Locked)** - students enrolled at the end of the school year, according to the state accountability data that is locked on 7/1

New Exit Withdraw Types Added

The following descriptors have been added

Code Value	Description
213	Transfer Out to a Nebraska Public School
214	Transfer Out to a Special Purpose School
215	Transfer Out to a Nebraska Nonpublic School
216	Transfer Out to an Exempt (Home) School
217	Transfer Out to Another State or Country

So 201 Exit Type Removed

The following descriptor has been removed

Code Value	Description
201	Transfer Out



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New SPED Reason Exited

The following Descriptor has been added

Code Value	Description	PART B OR C
SPED18	Parent or legal guardian revoked consent for Special Education Services	Part B

- Student served in special education at the start of the reporting period, but at some point during the reporting period, parent or legal guardian revoked special education services.
- These are students who no longer have an IEP and are receiving all of their educational services from a regular education program.



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New Attendance Event Categories

5.4 Attendance Event Category

The following Descriptors have been added

Code Value	Description
06	Excused Absence - Disciplinary action, not receiving instruction
07	Excused Absence - Illness/Medical
08	Excused Absence - Noninstructional activity recognized by state, district, or school
09	Excused Absence - Transportation not available
10	Excused Absence - Other
11	Unexcused Absence - Student skipping school
12	Unexcused Absence - Other or unknown

- District defines
- 02 Excused and 03 Unexcused have been removed
- Whatever Attendance Events coded as Excused or Unexcused last year, ensure they are mapped this year into the new ones



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New Residency Status

- 09 - Ward of the State/Court Assigned to a Group Home
- Students who have been placed by the state or courts in a group home located within the boundaries of a public school district and are enrolled in the district.
- *Specific for just two districts who have group homes where the students attend the public school*
- Contact Service Desk if you have questions around this new code



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New Learning Modality

- Any students who are in remote learning for at least part of their instruction need a record
 - Students who are full time, in person do not need a record
- Program information created on a school/district level
- Student assigned to program
- Begin Date
- End Date (only needed if student is changing Learning Modality “Program”)
- Dates need to be within Enrollment dates

- 10 - Instructional Day Split School and Remote
- 11 - Instructional Day Remote Learning

22-23 Staff Reporting



- 2 New Position Assignment Codes
- Coaches
 - Connect Coaches to districts in TEACH Business Partner Portal (BPP)
 - Only reporting Coaches who are not already reported under another position (ex. Teacher, Admin)
- Substitutes
 - Obtain start/end date for Subs
 - New Position Assignment Field - Days Worked (Subs only)
 - Close Substitute Teacher collection in CDC
- Data reported will be similar to Para positions – limited
- Potential Data Webinar this summer/fall if needed



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ADVISER Follow Up Collection

- Open: July 1, 2022
- Due: September 15, 2022
- Audit Window Close: October 2, 2022

Data Collected for 21-22

- Student and Teacher Course Section updates from Year End
- Year End enrollment updates (year-end dropouts, summer transfers and summer completers)
- Special Education (summer transfers and exiters)
- Title I

The Follow-Up Collection is meant ONLY for data that is not reportable by June 15th. All other data available in June is expected to be reported during the Year End Collection window.

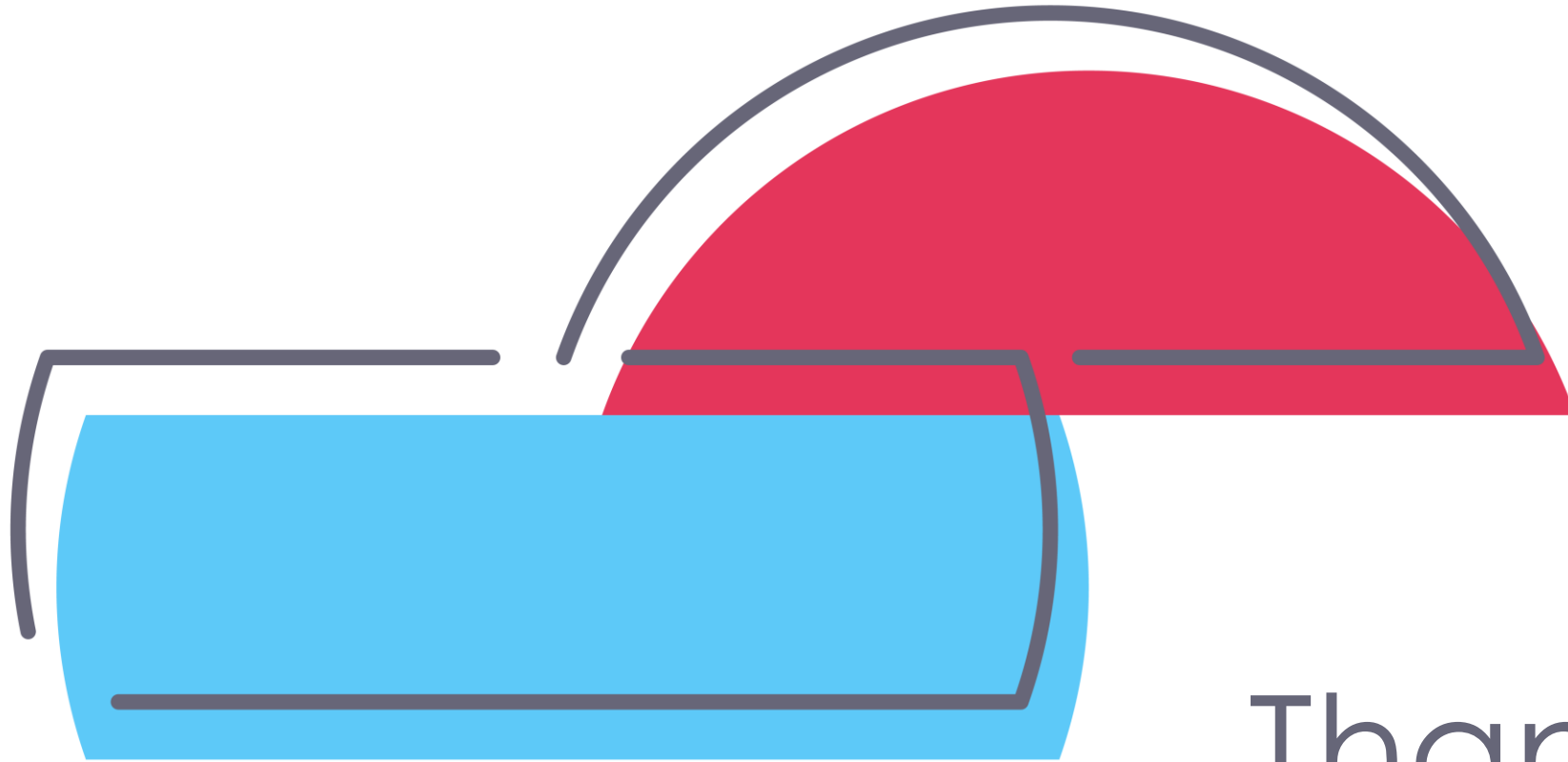
