ADVISER 21-22 Collections

- 21-22 data was due 10/2 – took almost 3 weeks for NDE to work with 82 districts that had late requests or tickets just before the window closed
- Barely got year end Special Education data ready to review before it was reported to DoE 11/2
 - Based on this if anything I'd prefer to move the due date earlier, but 10/2 is the final effective date to change dropouts
 - Is the 10/2 due date a problem?
 - Once these SPED exits are reported to the feds, NDE will reject late requests to change it – report SPED changes in summer of the new year
 - You may create errors that you aren't going to be able to resolve



ADVISER 21-22 Collections

- Most late data was for transfers, graduates, and SPED exits, and much could have been corrected in May, June, or September
 - Does NDE need to provide districts any other data? Are districts unaware of what their exits show in June? Does the timing of your year end process affect this?
 - Have gotten a suggestion that we add new reports for next May
 - SPED 12th graders – with SPED exit and enrollment exit codes
 - Transfers/etc. student list, similar to Completers/Dropouts/Not Enrolled Eligible To Return reports but covering other exit codes



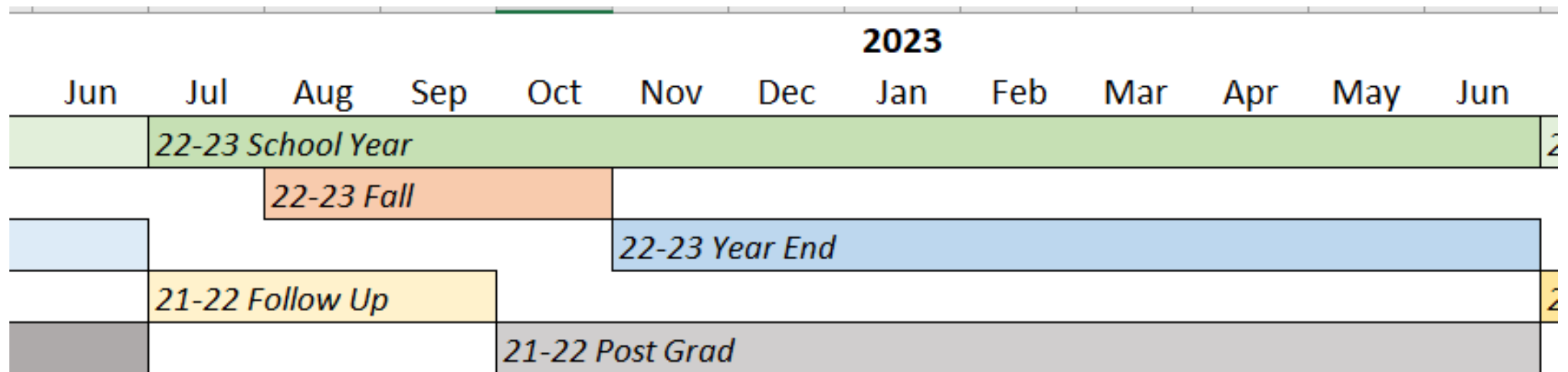
ADVISER 21-22 Collections

- Many districts seem to partly rely on validation errors that trigger after the new year's data is submitted that point to students missing from the prior year
 - Is there a reason this is preferred over looking at reports in the prior year?
 - Keep in mind these errors can never really be valid until after your SIS (and SRS) are publishing data in the new year
- NDE will make a change before next Fall – these validation errors that look at enrollments and SPED records from the prior year will be shown in their own category of errors, like “Returning Students”
 - Perhaps we will list these errors under both school years in ADVISER Validation
- All districts should review these as part of the Follow Up Collection next year, NDE will add them to the checklist



ADVISER 21-22 Collections

- Now that all 21-22 data is generally locked, the above errors as well as Lookups in the Validation website now point to the locked 21-22 data rather than live
- The only data still being reported in 21-22 is Post Graduate Activities





2021-2022 Graduation Cohorts

- NDE has processed 250 Graduation Cohort Resolution Requests since 10/2
- **Grad/Dropout Rates are now available to districts in the NEP Secure**
- Districts must **submit any additional requests by 11/11** in order to be included in the public NEP release, otherwise they will show up next year (these are always available, unlike late requests)
- Because of our earlier Follow Up due date many of these may be unavoidable, but also some requests are for data that would've been known in *May*



2021-2022 NEP Release

- NDE is currently working on getting things prepared for the public NEP release
 - No date confirmed yet but it could be next week
- **NDE will send emails to superintendents that will have a link to preview the public NEP** two days before the public release, so that other data in the state can be previewed
- Most data on the NEP is not available to be changed at this point – it is data that was due in June/October, as well as statewide assessment data that has already been reviewed
 - NDE may consider some late changes if they have a serious effect on AQuESTT accountability
 - Attendance data was locked in June, NDE will not change the locked data due to school audit findings but live data could be updated if that helps with audit



What's next in 2022-2023

- NDE is beginning to work through late requests/tickets from Fall Collection - including ADVISER, Staff Reporting, and CDC
- Course related reports have been turned on for 22-23, including non endorsed staff in NSSRS Validation
- NDE should activate the 22-23 graduation rate calculations and GCAT report within about one week
- The ELPA, ACT, and Alternative assessment roster reports will be opened in ADVISER Validation (needs 22-23 cohort data for ACT), data must be checked in early January like usual



What's next in 2022-2023

- New CRDC reports for 21-22 OCR submission
 - Plans still up in the air, but based on how last year went the new idea is for NDE to offer districts a CRDC format file through ADVISER Validation that can be downloaded then uploaded by yourself, with no intervention from NDE
- Adding new Instructional Unit reports, as mentioned in prior webinars
- Other suggested changes from users
