We have Administrators that do not sign up for the sessions because they happen randomly in the middle of the morning when they are busy with other issues. If you went back to the in person conference more of our school personnel would take the time to go and attend the sessions then are watching the zoom sessions.

I like going to an ESU, you can collaborate with other users.

Webinars are impersonal. In person Data Conferences allowed us to interact with other districts and vendors - put faces with names and have human connections. This was the only opportunity for us to meet with other data stewards around the district and learn about all aspects of NDE. These are greatly missed as you can't cover all topics discussed at these Data Conferences. The breakout sessions where you chose which topics to listen to were immensely valuable - even if you did an all day conference in lieu of 2 day conference. Our administrators and teachers have conferences that they attend throughout the country that provide immense value to their profession - webinars are NOT the same.

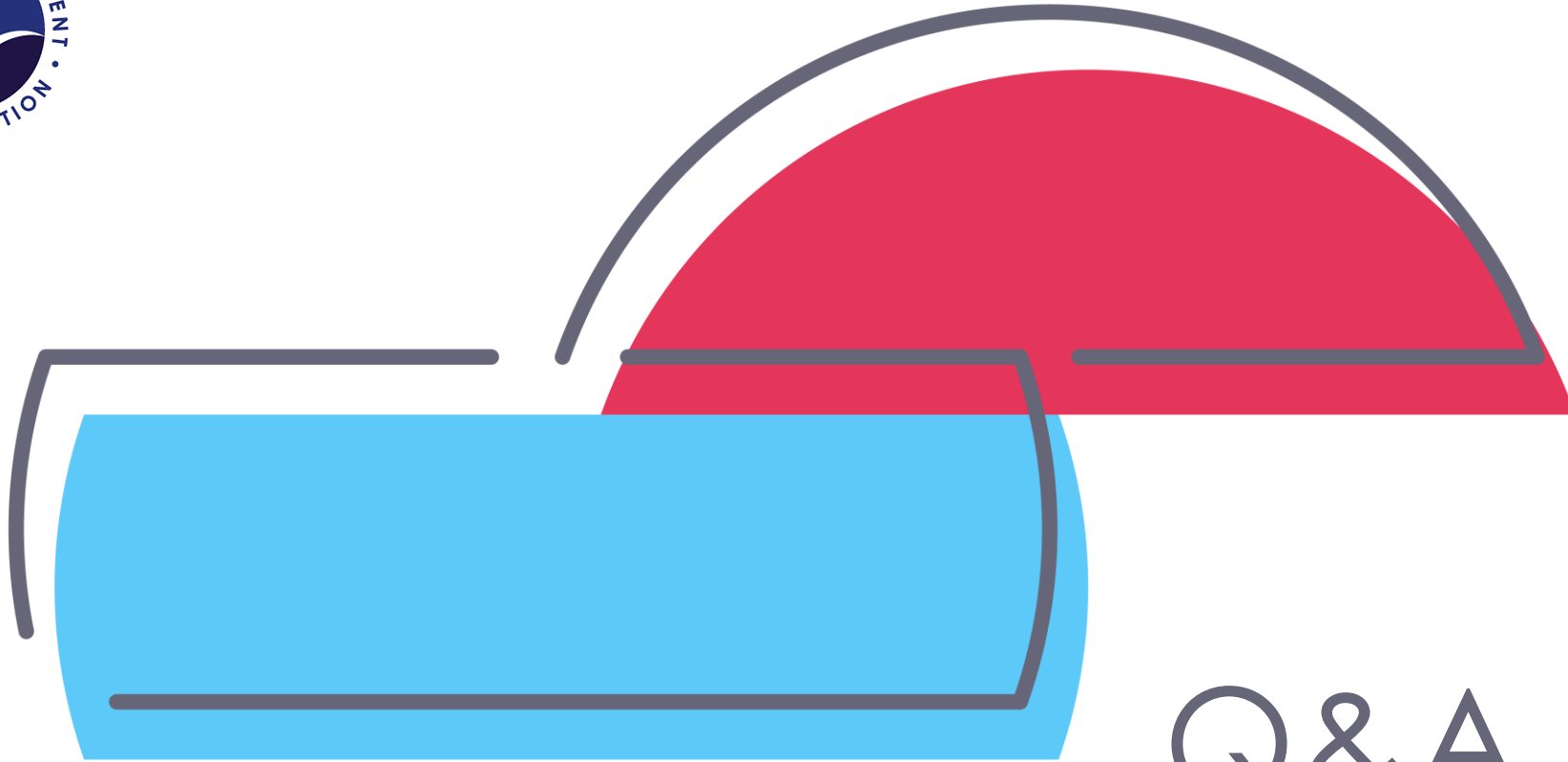
Coding on-line classes is going to be big from here on out.
