



Perkins Definitions



Secondary: A secondary student who, in grades 9-12, has earned credit in at least two courses in a single career cluster program at the intermediate or capstone level.

(Introductory courses will not count towards a student being identified as a CTE Concentrator.)

Postsecondary: A postsecondary student who has, in the reporting year, earned twelve (12) credits in a *single* CTE program OR completed a CTE program if that program encompasses fewer than twelve (12) credits.

Secondary: A CTE participant is defined as an individual at the secondary level who completes at least one CTE course in a CTE program or program of study. Students may participate in more than one career area.

Postsecondary: At the postsecondary level, a CTE participant who completes at least one CTE course in a CTE program or program of study.

Special Populations include:

- Individuals with disabilities
- Individuals from economically disadvantaged families, including low-income youth and adults
- Individuals preparing for nontraditional fields
- Single parents, including single pregnant women
- Out-of-workforce individuals
- English learners
- Homeless individuals
- Youth who are in, or have aged out of, the foster care system
- · Youth with a parent who is a member of the armed forces and is on active duty

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who, during the second quarter after program completion, remain enrolled in postsecondary education, are in advanced training, military service, or a service program that receives assistance under Title 1 of the National and Community Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12511 et seq.), are volunteers as described in section 5(1) of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C. 2504(a)) or are retained in employment. *(Concentrators who graduated by June 30, 2019 would be assessed between October 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019).*

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who completed their program in the reporting year.

*Retention includes students who remained enrolled in their original postsecondary institution or transferred to another 2- or 4- year institution during the reporting year.

Rerkins Secondary Indicators

1S1: Four-Year Graduation Rate:

The percentage of CTE concentrators who graduate high school, as measured by the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate (defined in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965).

Numerator: The number of CTE concentrators who graduated from high school, as measured by the fouryear adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who, in the reporting year, were included in the State's computation of its adjusted four-year cohort graduation rate as defined in the State's Consolidated Accountability Plan.


3S1: Post-Program Placement


Numerator: The number of CTE concentrators who, in the second quarter after graduating from high school in the previous reporting year, are in postsecondary education or advanced training, military service or a service program that receives assistance under Title I of the National and Community Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12511 et seq.), are volunteers as described in section 5(1) of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C. 2504(a)) or are employed. (Concentrators who graduated by June 30, 2018 would be assessed between October 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018).

Denominator: The number of CTE concentrators who graduated high school during the previous reporting year.

Concentrator who has a 2021 graduation and goes on to post secondary education after graduating from HS






