

ADVISER 2022-2023 Follow Up

- The Follow Up collection was finished 3 weeks after the 10/2 due date due to working through late issues
- After this is done, NDE merges data from the Follow Up collection into the final Year End data snapshot, but not other data that is not part of the Follow Up
- This delays NDE being able to get a final set of 22-23 student data which is used for the 23-24 Prior School Year errors, demographics for statewide assessment on NEP, finalizing CTE Perkins data, and more
- There were even more issues with districts or vendors inadvertently destroying the prior year's data then ever



ADVISER 2022-2023 Follow Up

- NDE would like to consider significantly limiting what can be reported in the next Follow Up window to avoid issues, please offer feedback in the Q&A screen
 - SPED & Title I data originally this was meant to be only for students that come into the district right before 6/30 and so weren't able to be reported in time, but we see lots of corrections of data from all year.
 - Could consider only looking at loading data with begin dates after a certain date, or only for individual students by request?
 - Districts would be expected to get the large majority of their data correct by 6/30



ADVISER 2022-2023 Follow Up

- Course Section/Grades data originally this was just meant for districts that don't get all of their async course data until after 7/1, or for summer school and makeup grades
 - Could the Follow Up only allow for changes to Grades & Attempt Statuses for normal courses, and only take section data for summer semester courses
 - CTE Perkins and Instructional Unit data would be locked in on 6/30
- Enrollments (Dropouts & Grads) by statute districts have until 10/2 to identify their dropouts from the prior year so this may not be changing
 - Could NDE just look at updating exit codes without updating all enrollment data? Might help avoid issues



ADVISER 2023-2024 Updates

- NDE still addressing late issues/request for Fall collection
- Within 1-2 weeks the 23-24 cohort data should be running nightly, and the GCAT report will be activated
- Before end of year the nightly course data will be activated for 23-24, which feeds data to CTE Perkins reports, Instructional Units, and Endorsed Teachers (incl. NSSRS report)
- NDE is nearly finished certification testing with vendors, see <u>2023-2024 ADVISER Vendor Certification Nebraska Department of Education</u>



2021-2022 CRDC

- CRDC collecting data from 12/11 through 2/26
- NDE will be putting out some enhancements to the existing visual reports, then adding a "CRDC Upload File" report that can be uploaded as a .csv file. NDE is not uploading anything for you this year.

- NDE will be rolling out some small updates to the Assessment and AQUESTT data on the NEP Secure based on district corrections, CSI/TSI designations are being communicated to districts today

November 22, 2023	All student data released on NEP Snapshot (public) site.
February 1, 2024	Financial data released to NEP Snapshot (public) site.
June 1, 2024	District SPED Performance Report Part B released to NEP Snapshot (public) site.
