#ATTENDANCEMATTERSVA: CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM AND THE ARTS IN VIRGINIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS

- Seniors enrolled in four years of fine arts courses each year since 2020 demonstrate a 32% to 50% lower absenteeism rate than those who did not take a fine arts course during high school.
- These findings hold true when comparing data across fine arts
 disciplines and for key variables such as race/ethnicity, enrollment in
 Free and Reduced-Price Meals programs, and English Learners.


